



School Fundraising Guidelines

1. Only the BotsIQ committee should solicit Primary Sponsors for the BotsIQ event. If a school finds a company that is interested in event sponsorship, the school should direct the company to contact Paul Anselmo of the BotsIQ Finance Committee (anselmo@ncsquared.com).
2. Schools may solicit bot building supplies, and technical expertise from any company (manufacturing and non manufacturing companies). They may also solicit funding to purchase bot building supplies, team shirts, or to cover travel expenses for the team.
3. Teams may conduct fundraising sales activities.

Acknowledgement of industry advisors and contributors:

1. Industry advisors should be acknowledged with the company name on the bot. This is a requirement of the BotsIQ regulations.
2. Industry technical advisors should be recognized in the BotsIQ advertisement/marketing and in the competition program.
3. The schools should acknowledge contributors to the school teams. The acknowledgement may take the form of additional decals on the bots or on the teams' shirts
4. The primary industry technical advisor(s) and the contributors should be acknowledged in a paragraph written by the students and included in the competition program. The program paragraph will not exceed 150 words and should include acknowledgements of all of the team's contributors.
